Household Yard Waste Disposal Options

1. Year Round Program

Free drop-off at Glenmore and Westside Landfills for grass, leaves, pine needles and cones, windfall fruit, garden plants, and prunings up to 1 cm (1/2") in diameter delivered by residents any time of the year.

2. Chip It Months

Free drop-off at Glenmore and Westside Landfills for yard waste and prunings up to 20 cm (8") in diameter, delivered by residents during March, April, October and November.

3. Yard Waste Collection

Spring and fall yard waste pick-up for grass, leaves, pine needles, pine cones, corn and tomato stalks, garden plants, and prunings up to 1 cm (1/2") in diameter. Fall pick-ups are:

Kelowna & Regional District:
Oct. 22-26 and Nov. 19-23

Peachland & Lake Country:
Oct. 8-12 and Nov. 5-9
