Board Approves Capital Equipment Purchases for Hospital

The Regional Hospital District (RHD) Board is made up of the same members as the Regional District Board, and is responsible for funding 40% of capital expenditures for the Regional Hospital. As such, the Board approved capital equipment purchases from the 2003 budget on condition any proceeds from the disposal of the old equipment is credited to the purchase. The purchases will include an Ultrasound Machine, a Diagnostic Imaging Machine that allows patients to remain in a wheelchair during testing and a Cardiology Hemo Dynamic Monitoring System.

Only applicable for residents on regional or municipal collection.
